Michigan Sanctions for Violation of Alcohol Laws Related to Minors (under age 21)

- **Selling or Furnishing Alcohol to Minors**
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- **Use of Fraudulent ID by a Minor or Furnishing Fraudulent ID to a Minor**
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- **Purchase, Possession or Consumption of Alcohol by a Minor**
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- **Person Under 21 Transporting or Possessing Alcohol in a Motor Vehicle**
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Michigan Sanctions for Drinking and Driving Offenses

- **Operating a Motor Vehicle While Impaired**
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 - **For first offense with a blood alcohol content (BAC) of .08 or higher**

 - **For first offense with a BAC of .17 or higher**

 - **If under age 21, it is also against the law to drive with a BAC of .02 or more**

 - **Drivers with any amount of a Schedule 1 narcotic**
 - **Anyone who refuses a breath test**
